
Our church continues to be blessed to be able to reach out into the community and help organizations in need through the generosity of our members and the work and fundraising done by

Our youth members used the Sunday School time during Lent to focus on the Almsgiving piece of Lent. The youth put together 12 larger bags that this church can use to give to people in need of assistance who come to the church looking for help. The youth also put together smaller Gallon size bags that each member of the congregation can put in their car to give to someone they see who is in need of help.

Each of the bags includes water, food and healthy snacks to help nourish a person's body. Included in every bag is a leaflet with several Bible verses to nourish their soul. The leaflet also contains information about other local organizations to contact for further assistance, such as God's Storehouse and House of Hope.

Putting together these bags brought great discussion with the youth about what God calls us to do and how to minister to others. It teaches the youth how to participate in outreach and provide kindness. It also allowed us to talk about how we can love one another and pray for one another even if we don't have the money to hand to someone. The bags were blessed by Rev. Grayce O'Neill Rowe on Sunday, March 10th and are available in the youth room for anyone who would like one to give to someone in need of assistance.

The Youth Sunday/Church Picnic Day will be May 12th and we will be getting the youth ready and planning for that in the coming weeks. Please continue to pray for the youth of our church and their ministry in the world.

With the church shining on the outside and the inside we will be ready to celebrate Easter and the blessings that come with that day.

Last fall the Vestry approved the removal of the playground equipment. Some of the wood structure had deteriorated, the plastic swings and accessories had become brittle from the sun, and some parts had broken leaving sharp edges.

On Monday March 25th Jerry Oakes and John Ross were able to disassemble the structure with the use of power tools and take it to the dump in less than an hour.
